Offer your child water often.

February is Dental Health Month

It is important to ...

- Brush your child's teeth for two minutes—two times a day.
- Use a tiny smear of fluoride toothpaste on your child's toothbrush. Increase to a pea-size drop at age 3.
- Begin flossing around teeth as soon as the first one appears.
- Offer water between meals.
- Begin dental visits at 1 year old.
- Take your child for a dental check every 6 months.
